Lincoln Street north of Witter Street

Lincoln Street (Expressway to E Grand Ave)

Current Phase: Phase 2 – (4/18/24 to 5/15/24)

Current Closure: Intersection at Chestnut St and north along Lincoln St thru Witter Street. The closure extends thru Witter St to a point approximately 500' north of Witter St. Local traffic can still enter from the north at Peach St and from the south at Chestnut St. D St property owners can still access D St from Chestnut St.

Proposed Closure: Next closure will be Phase 3 – Peach St intersection beginning May 16th.

This Week

• Storm sewer catch basins and associated piping were completed in the Witter St intersection and sanitary sewer work continued north of Witter St. Subgrading and road base installation continued as well. Solarus worked on setting the cover to the vault at the Chestnut St intersection and WWLC worked on relocating power poles.

Next Week

Road base work will continue next week in preparation for curb and gutter pouring later in the
week. Survey crews will finalize staking curb and gutter on Monday and Tuesday. Sanitary
and water main work will continue north of Witter St.
